Dear Pliant Customer:

As you are aware, Hurricane Ike made landfall along the Texas and Louisiana Gulf Coast on September 13, 2008. As a result of the hurricane, Pliant's operations have been disrupted and we expect to incur premium costs. We are currently assessing the full impact to our resin supply, including the ability of our suppliers to make deliveries of critical raw materials and services.

Based on our initial assessment, we expect that North American resin supply capabilities will be immediately reduced. As a consequence, it will be necessary to immediately allocate existing inventories and adjust prices of certain products.

The amount and price of each product that will be allocated to your company is still being determined. Your Pliant Sales Representative will contact you shortly to provide details.

Pliant regrets any impact this supply disruption may have on your business. We are committed to communicating in a timely manner. We thank you for your cooperation and patience as we work to fully restore our supply capability.
