Price Adjustment for Street's Process Supplies Effective April 1, 2009

Following our last general price adjustment in May of 2008, we experienced significant escalation in raw materials costs, particularly those costs affected by rising prices for energy, petroleum-derived raw materials, and transportation. Pricing levels for some commodities began to come off of their peak levels during the fourth quarter of 2008, transportation costs declined, and there is some continuing softening, however costs still remain considerably above the levels of one year ago.

Recognizing how distasteful price increases are in this difficult economy, we have worked to control costs, and have absorbed increases during the year. However, it is necessary to adjust prices modestly to reflect the higher costs of production. Price changes have been made on a product-by-product basis and you will find that the adjustments are generally less than 5%.

Changes will become effective for orders placed on or after Wednesday, April 1, 2009. All orders placed prior to this date for immediate shipment will be billed at current pricing.

A revised *Confidential Distributor Net Price Schedule* and a revised *Suggested Consumer Price Schedule* are attached.
