SCHEDULE A DRY STARCH LINE

Although we announced a General Price Revision effective February 26th, new steep increases in the price of grain commodities have necessitated further increases in the prices of our dry starch products. Grain price increases are due to the government's Ethanol Program.

The new ethanol plants in the United States are based on corn starch. One result, nevertheless, has been a shortage in wheat starches. Starch suppliers as a result are reluctant to guarantee their prices more than three months.

The increases in the prices of wheat and corn starches are of a magnitude not seen in our fifty years in business. We are left with no choice but to pass on these increases. It is hoped that the situation will improve but the feverish tempo of the Ethanol Program would indicate continuing price pressure on wheat and corn starches.
