Dear Valued Customer,

For the past few months the polyethylene suppliers have been pushing to implement a \$.04/lb resin increase. This \$.04 resin increase has become a reality as of September 1st. The suppliers are citing continued record export volumes, extremely low inventories throughout the supply chain, high operating rates, and rising costs on ethylene as the main reasons for this \$.04 resin increase. In addition, all resin suppliers have at least another \$.04 resin increase that they are pushing for October 1st. If this October resin increase is implemented, you should expect an additional price increase on all Epsilon Plastics products.

Based on the September 1, 2009 resin price increase, Epsilon Plastics will increase prices by 6% on all orders received on or after October 1, 2009.

Orders placed prior to this increase will be limited to a maximum of one month of your normal purchase levels. All orders must be for prompt delivery within our current lead times. Pricing for orders accepted is based upon available resin supply and Epsilon Plastics reserves the right to accept or decline all orders for any reason.

Please be assured that we will continue to support our loyal customers and work to minimize the impact that these increases have on your business. Thank you for your continued support and business.
